Half-tuition Scholarship: HK\$70,000 p.a. (renewable)

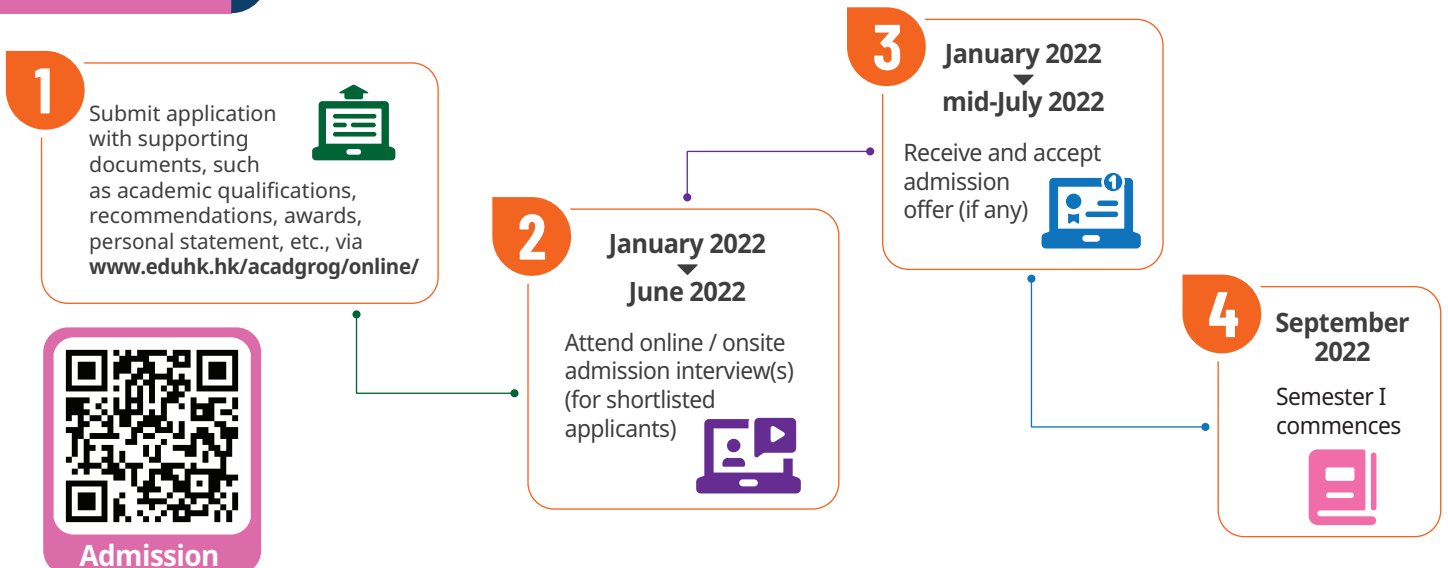
