

Entrance Scholarships (for Government funded programmes)

Full Scholarship: HK\$185,000 p.a. (renewable)

Tuition Scholarship: HK\$140,000 p.a. (renewable)

Half-tuition Scholarship: HK\$70,000 p.a. (renewable)

Entrance Scholarships will be granted to applicants with outstanding academic achievements who perform well at admission interviews. No separate application is required. Scholarships are renewable annually based on the student's performance at the University.
